

STATUTORY AND OTHER OFFICES REMUNERATION TRIBUNAL

REPORT AND DETERMINATION PURSUANT TO SECTION 14(2) OF THE STATUTORY AND OTHER OFFICES REMUNERATION ACT 1975 – FULL-TIME NON PRESIDENTIAL MEMBER, PERSONAL INJURY COMMISSION, (DIVISION HEAD, POLICE OFFICER SUPPORT SCHEME).

Request for determination

1. The Premier and the Special Minister of State jointly administer the *Statutory and Other Offices Remuneration Act 1975* (SOOR Act). In correspondence dated 30 May 2025, pursuant to section 14 of the SOOR Act, the Premier, the Hon Chris Minns MP, has directed the Tribunal to make a Special Determination regarding the remuneration for the office of Full-time non-presidential member, Personal Injury Commission (Division Head Police Officer Support Scheme).
2. In giving this direction, the Premier has advised the Tribunal that it is appropriate that the remuneration for the new Division Head Police Officer Support Scheme is consistent with current remuneration of the Division Head of Workers Compensation and Division Head of the Motor Accidents Division of the Personal Injury Commission, being \$333,715.

The Full-time non-presidential member, Personal Injury Commission, (Division Head, Police Officer Support Scheme).

3. The *Police Amendment (Police Officer Support Scheme) Act 2024* (the Act) commenced from the date of assent on 27 September 2024. It amended the *Personal Injury Commission Act 2020* (PIC Act) to establish a new Division, the Police Officer Support Scheme Division of the Personal Injury Commission. The Act also amended the *Police Act 1990*, to confer the Personal Injury Commission the function to hear and determine disputes relating to the Police Office Support Scheme.
4. The Personal Injury Commission is established by the PIC Act and became operational on 1 March 2021. It is an independent statutory tribunal within the New South Wales justice system.
5. The Division Head, Police Officer Support Scheme, will direct the business of the Commission in the Division, and hear and determine highly complex disputes. It is a full-time leadership and decision-making role.

6. In determining the remuneration for the new Division Head the Tribunal has had regard to the role and responsibilities of the Division Head Police Officer Support Scheme, supporting information provided to the Tribunal and the current remuneration of the Division Head of Workers Compensation and Division Head of Motor Accidents Divisions of the Personal Injury Commission.
7. In accordance with Premier's direction the Tribunal determines the annual salary of the of Full-time non-presidential member Personal Injury Commission, (Division Head, Police Officer Support Scheme) as \$333,715.

Determination

This determination amends the 2024 Annual Determination SOORT Public Office Holders, dated 15 July 2024.

Pursuant to section 14(2) of the SOOR Act, the Tribunal determines the annual salary for the office of Full-time non-presidential member Personal Injury Commission, Principal Member Division Head, Police Officer Support Scheme, shall be \$333,715, effective from date of assent, 27 September 2024.
